Formal Notification of Change of School Day from September 2019

On Thursday 21st March 2019 the full governing body met and voted to support the proposed changes to both phases of the school. This means that from September 2019:

The Secondary will close at 12:15 every Friday for Secondary Phase pupils.

The Primary will close at 12:30 every Friday for Primary Phase pupils.

Pupils who are in receipt of free school meals (FSM) will be able to order a grab bag which they will take home and eat for lunch; this applies across both phases of the school. A hot morning break will be on offer to all children, not just those on free school meals.

Parents of Primary Phase pupils who work on Friday afternoon and cannot organise child care can notify Mrs Bond, Deputy Headteacher in writing c/o the Primary Phase to apply for a place at our 'After School Club' that we are offering thanks to the support of Ms Daniels a registered Ofsted child minder who is greatly respected in our community and across North Manchester. Ms Daniels has worked in partnership with us for a number of years and we are delighted to be able work with her more closely and to offer this service to working parents of children in our Primary Phase.

I must stress that this offer is only open to working parents; those who intend to apply for a place at the 'After School Club' must provide evidence of their employment including the details of their employer and contact details at their place of work for safeguarding reasons.
